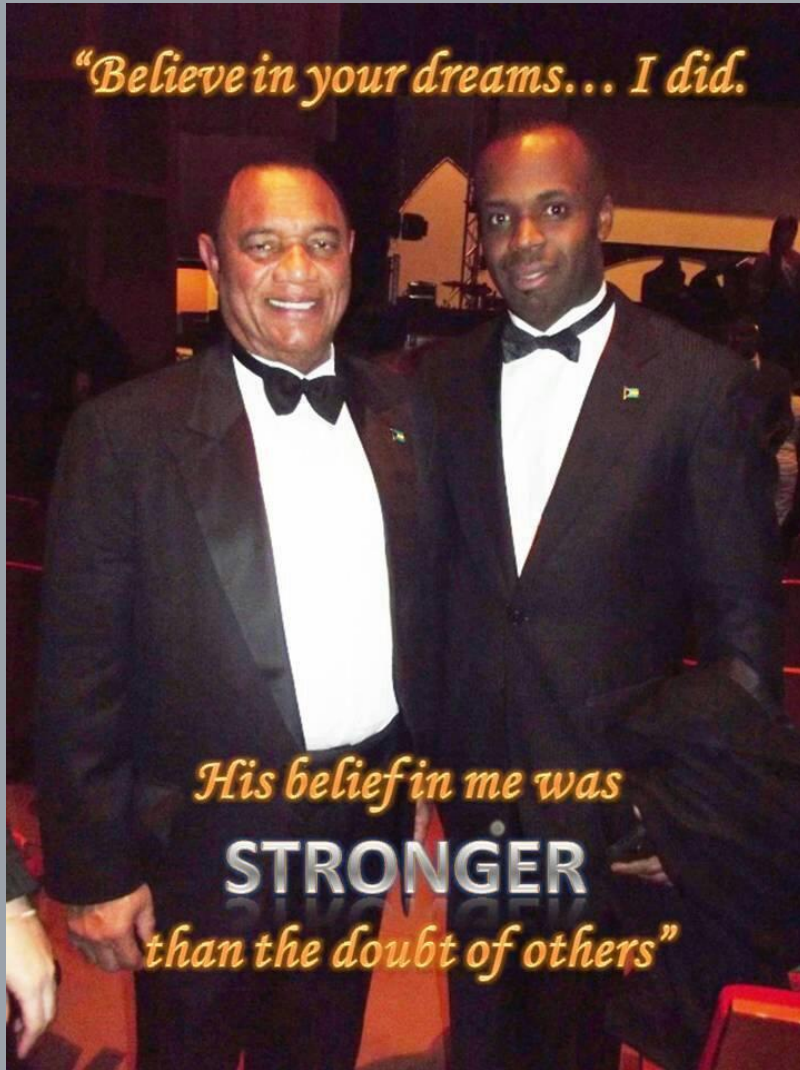

The Consulate General of The Bahamas in Atlanta was established to address the needs of Bahamian businesses and residents. Our jurisdiction includes the following states:

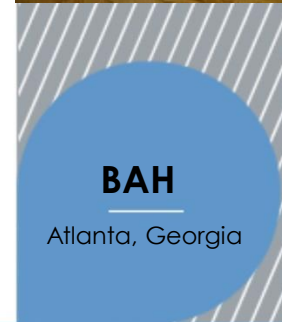

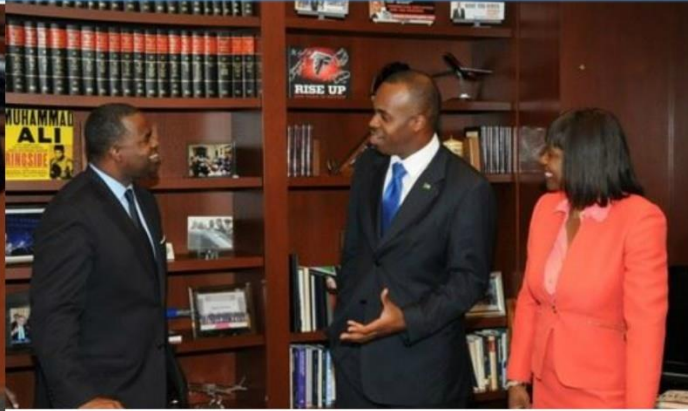

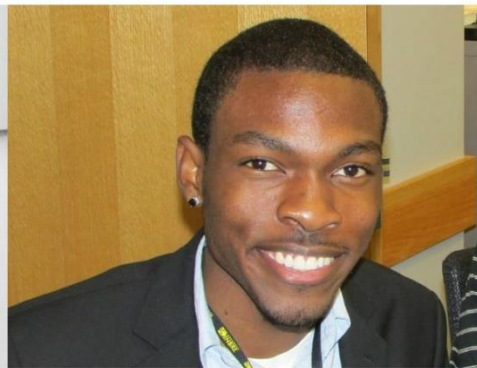


The Consul General has also made visits to incarcerated Bahamians, such as D. Ray James in Folkston, GA.
