



## Verification for Renewal of Driver's License

The Road Traffic Department has recently implemented a process in which Bahamian Residents may renew their Drivers Licenses outside of The Bahamas.

The document verification process for the Consulate is as follows:

- **Call the Consulate to make an appointment (The applicant must present themselves at the Consulate)**
- You must bring with you:
  - Two (2) Passport photos
  - Expired Driver's License (front and back)
  - Passport (first three pages)- pgs. 1 & 2 copied on one sheet of paper and pg. 3 copied on a second sheet of paper)
  - National Insurance Card (front and back)
  - The cost is \$30.00 per document, **not per photocopy** (Gazette 11<sup>th</sup> May 2015)
    - The Consulate can provide photocopies for \$5.00 per copy

Note: Please bring **both originals and copies of each document**. Only original documents will be verified.
