

STATEMENT REGARDING A LOST OR STOLEN BAHAMAS PASSPORT

IMPORTANT NOTICE: A Bahamian citizen may not bear more than one valid passport book at a time. It therefore is necessary to submit a statement with an application for a new Bahamas passport when a previously issued passport cannot be presented. Your statement must detail why the previous passport book cannot be presented. Should you locate the reported lost or stolen passport at a later time, submit it for cancellation directly to the Passport Office or the nearest Bahamas Consular Offices Overseas.
